Heat Treatment Preparation

Your home is scheduled for a bed bug heat treatment on: _____ by 1st Pest Control™. Vacating time will be 5 to 8 hours. We will introduce hot air to your home and raise the temperature to approximately 140-150 degrees Fahrenheit. In order to ensure a successful treatment, please perform the following preparation steps:

PRIOR TO TREATMENT:

- Please remove the following items from the treatment area prior to the commencement of the work. These and other items may be damaged by the heat:
- Persons, plants, animals (including fish)
 - Soft vinyl items
 - Candles, wax, crayons
 - Lipstick, nail polish, and other melt able cosmetics
 - Medicines and vitamins
 - Plastic or vinyl blinds
 - Arts and crafts assembled with vinyl, wax or glues
 - Photographs (may stick together)
 - Aerosol cans, fire extinguishers and other combustible items
 - Musical instruments
 - Cigarette lighters
 - Fresh fruit, vegetables, carbonated beverages and alcohol
 - Valuable oil paintings, acrylics (art work)
 - Antique furniture with fragile finish or glue points
 - Computer towers and laptops
 - Any other items that may be damaged by heat

Small items from the list above may be stored in the refrigerator prior to service beginning, larger items may be stored on the balcony (please ensure that there is space left on balcony for equipment and personnel to operate throughout the day) or in a storage unit should you have one. Please ensure that the items are bug free by completing a visual inspection prior to their removal from home. If for any reason, you are unsure of bug activity or whether or not an item may be damaged by heat, please consult one of our technicians.

- Please bag and run all clothing, linens, and blankets through a HIGH heat dryer cycle prior to the arrival of our technicians, after drying all items should be sealed in new/unused plastic garbage bags and placed in your bathroom tub for storage until the end of treatment. If your clothing is dry-clean only or leather please leave those items hanging in your closet.
- Reduce and eliminate clutter as much as possible before we arrive.
- Please remove electrical switch plates and plug covers.
- Please unplug any other electronics such as TVs, radios, clocks, etc.

Take nothing with you on treatment day other than the clothes on your back. If any items you take with you have bed bugs on them, the problem will start again.

Our technician may stand mattresses and box springs on end, move furniture away from the walls, remove items from closets, tip over sofas and couches, remove cushions, remove bedding etc. This may result in dirt and dust being disturbed. We will return items as close as possible to their original location. **We will not vacuum and clean after the treatment.**

We may use vacuums and steam plus some of the following chemicals:

Masterline – (lambda cyhalothrin 0.03% PCP 31300), Tempo WP – (cyfluthrin 1.0% PCP 25673) and 110 ULV – (pyrethrins 1.0% PCP 15330)

Occasional bubbling, lifting and separating of laminate furniture may occur and may need to be re-applied after the heating process. 1st Pest Control™ is not responsible for any damage to residence or belongings.
