## HOW TO PREPARE FOR A COCKROACH TREATMENT

## People and pets DO NOT need to vacate

PRIOR TO TREATMENT:
Remove items from upper and lower cupboards
• e.g. pots, pans, food items.
Remove items from drawers
• e.g. towels and utensils.
Remove items from counter tops
e.g. small appliances, decorations, cookbooks.
Pull out fridge and stove (if possible)
Our technicians will not be permitted to move your large appliances, however behind the fridge and stove are primary hiding locations for
cockroaches.
Remove all old or ripped shelf paper
Clean all areas where items have been removed
• Cleaning these areas is essential to a successful treatment. The goal of cleaning these areas is to eliminate any crumbs, grease and food particles that may have accumulated.
Don't forget to clean behind your fridge, stove, microwave and any other appliances you may have.
POST-TREATMENT:
Replace all shelf paper
• loose or old shelf paper may have accumulated food debris over time and should be replaced with new shelf paper.
Ensure that all food is stored carefully
• Sealed in Tupperware or pest-proof containers.
Return all contents back to their original place
Throw out garbage
<ul> <li>All garbage must be thrown out daily to limit potential food sources for the cockroaches.</li> </ul>
Fix dripping taps or leaking pipes
SAFETY INFORMATION:
We will be applying:
• Maxforce Gel Bait (hydramethylnon 2.15% PCP 24240), Avert Dry Flowable (abamectin B1 0.05% PCP 28403), or Maxforce Impact Gel Bait
(clothianidin 1.0% PCP 32275).
Avoid touching treated areas upon re-entry for as long as possible

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:
Please do not use insecticide sprays or harsh cleaners
• These items will render our treatment ineffective.
Additional activity after treatment
• You may experience activity for up to two (2) weeks after the initial treatment. If activity continues into the third week, you may need a follow up treatment.
