Follow-Up Treatment

HOW TO PREPARE FOR A FABRIC PEST TREATMENT

People and pets need to vacate for six (6) hours after treatment is completed

	Remove all items from dressers	, closets and other storage areas whe	re clothing is kept

- All clothing items should be run through a dryer set on high heat for a minimum of thirty (30) minutes.
- All items that are dry-clean only (leather, wool, suits, etc.) should be dry-cleaned or brushed to remove insect eggs, larvae, and adult insects.
- · Non-clothing items should be removed, bagged and placed outside of these storage locations until after treatment has been completed.

☐ Move items away from walls

- All items must be moved a minimum of six (6) inches away from walls throughout the entire home.
- All closets/mechanical rooms must have access along the baseboard (area where the wall meets the floor).
- Do not stack items on couches or beds as they will be treated and may need to be moved by our technicians.
- Heavy furniture and built-in cabinets may be left in place.

□ Launder bed linens and pet bedding

• All linens currently on beds and pet bedding must be laundered on hot settings and dried on the high heat setting.

□ Reduce clutter

- Fabric pests and other small insects can feed on paper products and cardboard boxes.
- They tend to hide in cluttered areas, especially near sources of heat and moisture.

☐ Thoroughly vacuum the unit

- All carpets and floors must be vacuumed.
- Vacuum all floor level cracks and other crevices, as well as along the joints in closets and dressers.
- · Vacuum the cracks in lather or wool covered furniture and the back side of throw rugs and Persian style carpets (if possible).

POST-TREATMENT:

- ☐ Thoroughly vacuum the unit
 - · Continue to vacuum all carpeted areas, rugs, couches and chairs DAILY for one (1) week after treatment has been completed.
- ☐ Return all contents back to their original place

SAFETY INFORMATION:

- ☐ All people and pets must vacate for a minimum of SIX (6) HOURS
 - People with allergies, respiratory issues, pregnant or nursing women or children under two (2) years must vacate EIGHT (8) to TWELVE (12) HOURS OR OVERNIGHT.

☐ We will be applying:

- Dragnet (premethrin 0.5% PCP 24175) 110ULV (pyrethrins 1.0% PCP 15330)
- ☐ Aquariums must be covered and filters turned off
- □ Please ventilate for ten (10) minutes upon re-entry and avoid touching treated areas for as long as possible
- ☐ In an emergency, contact POISON CONTROL at 604-682-5050 or 1-800-567-8911

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- □ Do not steam clean carpet, furniture or wash baseboards for thirty (30) days after treatment
 - steam cleaning, washing or mopping of these areas will render our treatment ineffective.

□ Additional activity after treatment

- You may experience activity for up to two (2) weeks after the initial treatment. If activity continues into the third week, a follow-up treatment may be required.
- □ Long-term control
 - Reduction of temperature and humidity, and allowing free airflow in your suite and especially in storage areas will aid in the success of our treatment and the long-term control of fabric pests.

IF THE ABOVE IS NOT COMPLETED IT MAY BE IMPOSSIBLE TO ELIMINATE THE PROBLEM
