HOW TO PREPARE FOR A SILVERFISH/FIREBRAT TREATMENT

People and pets need to vacate for four (4) hours after treatment is completed

PRIOR TO TREATMENT – KITCHEN AND BATHROOM:

- ☐ **Remove items from lower cupboards and drawers**
 - e.g. pots, pans, food items, paper products, etc.
- ☐ **Pull out fridge and stove (if possible)**
 - Our technicians will not be permitted to move your large appliances, however behind the fridge and stove are primary hiding locations for silverfish and firebrats.
- ☐ **Remove all old or ripped shelf paper**
- ☐ **Reduce clutter**
 - Silverfish feed on paper products and cardboard boxes.
 - They tend to hide in cluttered areas, especially near sources of heat and moisture.
- ☐ **Move items away from walls**
 - All items must be moved a minimum of six (6) inches away from walls throughout the entire home.
 - All closets/mechanical rooms must have access along the area where the wall meets the floor.
 - heavy furniture and built in cabinets may be left in place.
- ☐ **Clean all areas where items have been removed**
 - Cleaning these areas is essential to a successful treatment. The goal of cleaning these areas is to eliminate any crumbs, grease and food particles that may have accumulated.
 - Don't forget to clean behind your fridge, stove, microwave and any other appliances you may have.

POST TREATMENT:

- ☐ **Replace all shelf paper**
 - Loose or old shelf paper may have accumulated food debris over time and should be replaced with new shelf paper.
- ☐ **Ensure that all food is stored carefully**
 - Sealed Tupperware or pest-proof containers.
- ☐ **Return all contents back to their original place**
- ☐ **Fix dripping taps or leaking pipes**
- ☐ **Thoroughly vacuum the unit**
 - Vacuum all carpets and all floor level cracks and crevices.

SAFETY INFORMATION:

- ☐ **All people and pets must vacate for a minimum of FOUR (4) HOURS**
 - People with allergies, respiratory issues, pregnant or nursing women or children under two (2) years must vacate EIGHT (8) to TWELVE (12) HOURS OR OVERNIGHT.
- ☐ **We will be applying:**
 - Dragnet (permethrin 0.5% PCP 24175) or Drione Dust (pyrethrins 1.0% PCP 15255)
- ☐ **Please ventilate for ten (10) minutes upon re-entry and avoid touching treated areas for as long as possible**
- ☐ **In an emergency contact POISON CONTROL at 604-682-5050 or 1-800-567-8911**

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:

- ☐ **Long-term control**
 - Reduction of temperature and humidity in your suite will aid in the success of our treatment.
- ☐ **Additional activity after treatment**
 - You may experience activity for up to two (2) weeks after the initial treatment. If activity continues into the third week, a follow up treatment may be required.
