## **HOW TO PREPARE FOR A STORED PRODUCT PEST TREATMENT**

**People and pets need to vacate for six (6) hours after treatment is completed**

### **PRIOR TO TREATMENT - KITCHEN:**

- ☐ **Identify the source**
  - Examine all dried foods, including pet food, regardless of whether the packaging is open or not.
  - Once the source has been located, immediately remove the infested product from the home.
- ☐ **Remove items from the upper and lower cupboards, drawers, and countertops**
  - e.g. pots, pans, food items, etc.
- ☐ **Pull out fridge and stove (if possible)**
  - Our technicians will not be permitted to move your large appliances, however behind the fridge and stove are primary hiding locations for stored product pests.
- ☐ **Remove all old or ripped shelf paper**
- ☐ **Clean all areas where items have been removed**
  - Cleaning these areas is essential to a successful treatment. The goal of cleaning these areas is to eliminate any crumbs, grease and food particles that may have accumulated.
  - Don't forget to clean behind your fridge, stove, microwave and any other appliances you may have.
- ☐ **Reduce clutter**
  - Stored product pests and other small insects will tend to hide in cluttered areas, especially near sources of heat and moisture.
  - They tend to feed on paper products, cardboard boxes and food items.

### **POST TREATMENT:**

- ☐ **Replace all shelf paper**
  - Loose or old shelf paper may have accumulated food debris over time and should be replaced with new shelf paper.
- ☐ **Ensure that all food is stored carefully**
  - Sealed in Tupperware or pest-proof containers.
- ☐ **Return all contents back to their original place**
- ☐ **Throw out garbage**
  - All garbage must be thrown out daily to limit potential food sources for the stored product pests.

### **SAFETY INFORMATION:**

- ☐ **All people and pets must vacate for a minimum of SIX (6) HOURS**
  - People with allergies, respiratory issues, pregnant or nursing women or children under two (2) years must vacate EIGHT (8) to TWELVE (12) HOURS OR OVERNIGHT.
- ☐ **We will be applying:**
  - Dragnet (permethrin 0.5% PCP 24175) 110ULV (pyrethrins 1.0% PCP 15330)
- ☐ **Aquariums must be covered and filters turned off**
- ☐ **Please ventilate for ten (10) minutes upon re-entry and avoid touching treated areas for as long as possible**
- ☐ **In an emergency, contact POISON CONTROL at 604-682-5050 or 1-800-567-8911**

### **ADDITIONAL INFORMATION:**

- ☐ **Please do not wash baseboards or cupboards for thirty (30) days after treatment**
  - Mopping or using harsh cleaners in these areas will render our treatment ineffective.
- ☐ **Additional activity after treatment**
  - You may experience activity for up to three (3) weeks after the initial treatment. If activity continues into the fourth week, a follow up treatment may be required.

**IF THE ABOVE IS NOT COMPLETED IT MAY BE IMPOSSIBLE TO ELIMINATE THE PROBLEM**
